

Steel House Constitution Overview
2009-2010 School Year

KITCHEN USE:

- Residents may NOT use the kitchen between the hours of 2:30 and 5:00, Monday through Friday while the cook is at the house.
- Residents must abide by all Idaho State Health Code Regulations including washing hands before handling food and wearing some version of footwear in kitchen and dining room.
- Residents may not eat food out of the kitchen cupboards or fridge.
- Residents may have guests but need to pay as follows: \$2 for breakfast; \$3 for lunch; \$4 for dinner. Please pay Samm. Failure to do so will result in a fine.

MAGAZINES AND NEWSPAPERS:

- Newspapers (other than Argonaut) must stay in dining or living room
- Residents must wait two days before cutting any articles or items out of a newspaper

LAUNDRY:

- Laundry facilities are for residents ONLY
- Residents may sign up for a 3-hour laundry slot each week.

GUESTS:

- Guests are welcome at Ethel Steel House, but the resident is responsible for her guests. Any rules broken by the guests will be the responsibility of the member.
- The only bathroom available to male guests is the study room bathroom.
- All guests must be escorted 24 hours a day.

FINES:

- Fines are assessed if chores are missed; 1st miss = warning. 2nd miss = \$5. 3rd miss = \$10. 4th miss = \$20
- Fines must be paid within one week. (Fine monies are used for social events.)
- Additional fines of \$10 are due if special jobs aren't completed during finals week.

GENERAL:

- Personal items are NOT to be left on the main floor or in the TV room. You MAY claim a "space" for study materials in the study room.
- No swearing on the main floor.
- No homework, phones, or computers during house meetings.
- There are two mandatory meetings per month.
- Bikes are not allowed to be stored in the house, unless they are in the trunk room.
- Sleeping is for the porches... not the public areas of the house, including TV room.
- Residents may store personal food in room fridges or study room fridge only. Dining room fridge is for breakfast and lunch items.
- House trash bags are not for personal use.
